

Self-Officiated Playing Rules

When a player is fouled in the act of shooting:

On a Made Shot: If the basket is made it will count. Player will go to the free throw line to take one shot on a made basket. If the shot is missed play resumes as normal. If the shot is made the ball is taken out from underneath the basket.

Missed basket: If the basket is missed the player will be awarded two or three shots depending on if the shot was taken behind or inside the three-point line. After the last shot ball must be taken out underneath the basket.

When a team reaches the Bonus:

Bonus is reached when either team has a **total of (6)** fouls not seven (7). In this case teams will need to line up as they would normally during a free throw.

This fouled player will be awarded **(two foul shots)** not one and one. If the second shot is missed play resumes as normal. If the second shot is made take the ball out of bounds underneath the basket.

Note: There is no double bonus when a team reaches 10 fouls during the course of the game.

Jump Ball:

The home team (first number on schedule) will determine possession at the start of the game. Arrow will dictate possession after that.

- Both the offensive and defensive teams may call all fouls and violations. Be fair, honest, and consistent with your calls.

- If there is an instance in which both teams do not agree on a call, the staff at the score table will make the final call. **The sideline supervisor has the authority to overrule calls or make calls during the course of the game.**
