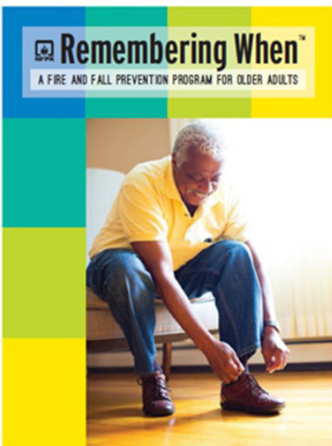

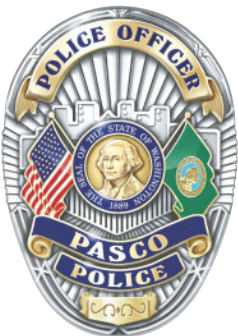

Cancellation Policy

- Recreation Services reserves the right to cancel, reschedule or combine activities as needed.
- If an activity is cancelled, participants will be notified by phone and a full refund will be issued.

Waiting List

If your desired class is full, we can place your name on a waiting list. If a spot becomes available or we are able to add more capacity, you will be contacted in the order on the waitlist. Spots will be filled on a first come first serve basis and not based on the order on the waitlist.

Withdrawal Policy - Individual class

- Withdrawal requests made 7 days or more prior to the first day of class will receive a full refund, less a \$5 processing fee and any other charges already incurred prior to start of class. (ie: T-shirts or class materials)
- Withdrawal requests made less than 7 days prior to the first class, but at least 24 hrs before class begins, receive a 50% refund less any other charges already incurred prior to start of class unless otherwise stated.
- **No refunds on Swim Lessons or Lampson Cable Bridge Run**
- No refunds will be given once class begins.
- Out of town trip withdrawal requests must be received at least 15 days prior to event departure to receive a full refund less a \$5 processing fee, less than 15 days will not receive a refund.
- League refunds will not be issued once the schedules are published.

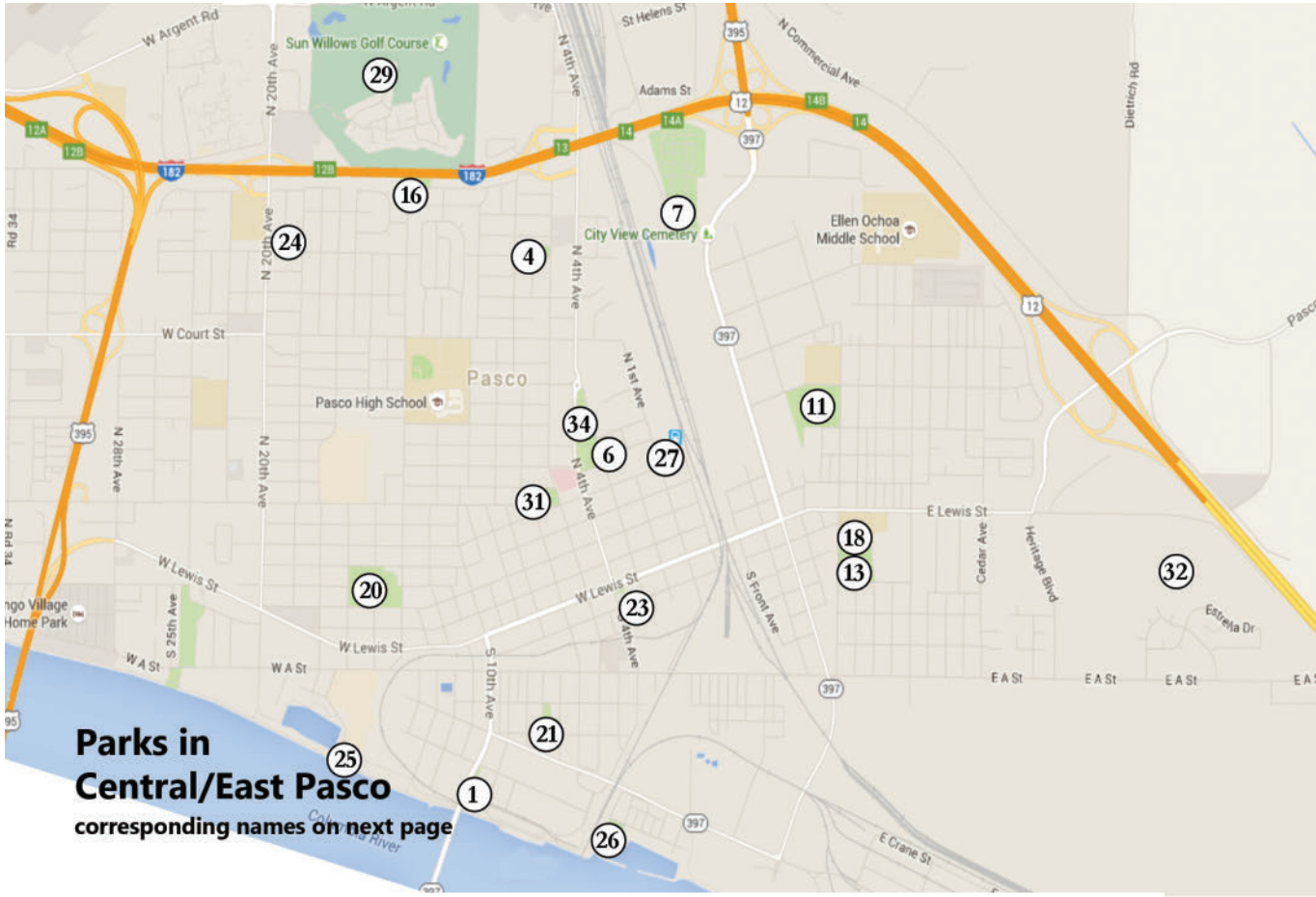
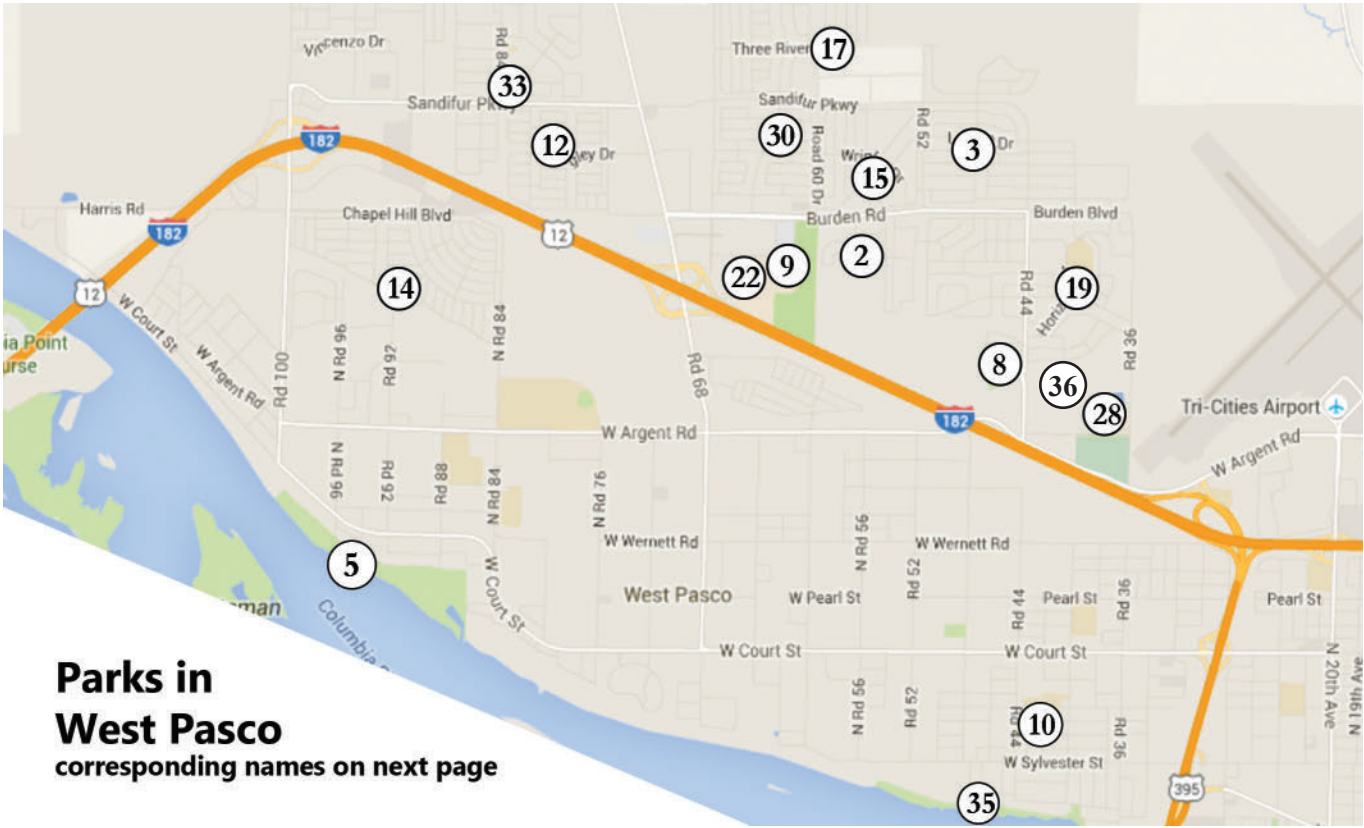
