

MELTED CRAYON SUNCATCHER

Supplies Needed To Make a basic Suncatcher:

- Crayons
- Sharpener
- Wax Paper
- Glue
- String/Yarn
- Iron

Additional Items to make an Animal Suncatcher

- Googly Eyes
- Construction Paper

DIRECTIONS

- Pick out the colors you want for your Suncatcher
- Remove the paper from each crayon
- Sharpen crayons with crayon or pencil sharpener or hand grater
- Gather up the shavings into one place, like a bowl or paper plate
- Lay wax paper down
- Have kids sprinkle the crayon shavings onto it
- Place another piece of wax paper on top

ADULTS ONLY For this next step you'll be using an iron

- Place the completed wax paper between 2 towels
- Slowly iron the paper, checking every few seconds to see if the crayon shavings have completely melted.
- Once melted, set project aside to dry
- Once dry, trim it into a circle and set aside
- Poke hole into finished project and attach string/yarn

TO MAKE AN ANIMAL

- Cut the head, tail, arms, and legs out of construction paper
- Glue them to your finished wax paper project
- Attach the googly eyes or draw them in
