REVISE Project Name to **Oregon Avenue Overlay (SR397)**

2. REVISE the PROJECT LENGTH

ALL REFERENCES TO OREGON AVENUE OVERLAY (SR397) PROJECT LENGTH 2.3 Miles

REVISE Project Length to **2.44 Miles**

3. Section 1.2 – INTENT OF THE CITY:

ADD the following underlined statement at the end of the third paragraph:

The selected Consultant is expected to work closely with the City's Public Works – Capital Improvements Program (CIP) Engineering Division as part of the project team to successfully complete this project. The anticipated timeframe for completing this design project is Friday, September 30, 2022 or sooner. The City reserves the right to select a different Consultant for each project. Selection(s) will be documented as outlined on the Local Agency Guidelines Manual (LAG) page 31-6.

4. Section 1.11 (C) – EVALUATION PROCESS:

ADD the following underlined statement to the fourth paragraph:

The City reserves the right to reject any or all of the submittals. If the City elects to select one of the submitting Consultants, the City will have the right to negotiate with said submitting Consultant over the final terms and conditions of the contract in the best interest of the City. The City reserves the right to select a different Consultant for each project. Selection(s) will be documented as outlined on the Local Agency Guidelines Manual (LAG) page 31-6. The primary objective of the negotiations is to maximize the City's ability to obtain the best value, based on the requirements and evaluations relating to this RFQ. If an agreement cannot be reached, the negotiations will be terminated and similar negotiations will occur with the second-ranked submitting Consultant.
