PMC 21.05.120 - Subdivision Regulations Assignment of water rights for subdivision of land

PMC 13.15.030(3) - Determination of Market Value for Payment in Lieu. The market value of water rights shall be determined periodically by the City Engineer, but not less frequently than every five years, based upon a water rights market study or similar investigation of the fair market value of perfected water rights that can be transferred to the City.

PMC 3.35.160 – Revenue and Finance

•In-lieu Fees: \$4,150/acre-foot (as of 11/27/2023)

- Irrigation Water: 50% of site @ 3 ¹/₂ acrefet/year per acre
- Potable Water: 0.3 acre-feet/residential unit
 Transfer Fee (Ecology)

What is Missing?

- 3 Respondents: ~4,000 acre-feet available
 Annual Payment: \$1,240,000.00

Understanding Water Rights

A CLOSER LOOK

We're reaching out to share vital information about our city's water rights and how changes will impact our community. It's important we all understand these changes to ensure Pasco continues to thrive.

WHAT ARE WATER RIGHTS?

Water rights allow us to use water from sources like the Columbia River. In Pasco, we're fortunate to have the right to utilize about 18,883 acre-feet of water annually for municipal drinking water purposes. For reference, an acre-foot of water can fill an acre of land one foot deep – that's a lot of water!

WHY UPDATE WATER RIGHTS RULES?

Our city is growing fast! In 2022 alone, we treated and sent to customers about 15,873 acre-feet of water. To keep up with the increasing demand for more water, especially for new homes and businesses, we need to ensure continued management of the city's water rights.

THE NEW CHANGES:

Water Rights Acquisition Fee: This fee helps us buy more water rights. Due to rising market values, we need to increase this fee from \$1,725 to \$4,150 per acre-foot. This big jump is because the value of water rights has increased by 140.6% since 2014.

Encouraging Water Rights Transfer: We prefer developers transfer existing water rights to the city. Then no fees are required. This helps us ensure there will be enough water rights to supply the new developments.





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
